Cybersecurity Enhancements - CY 2022

An ongoing effort to enhance cybersecurity of the exchange systems as part of Zero-Trust Security Model framework implementation.

Disaster Recovery & Business Continuity (Phase 1) - CY 2022

A new initiative to build a disaster recovery capability for ensuring business continuity. The primary objective of Phase 1 is to build a "lightweight" consumer portal site that can meet critical consumer requirements in the event of a disaster.

Mobile Platform Revamp - September 2022

A large initiative of revamping the mobile platform, user experience and the application components of the "Enroll MHC" Mobile App.
