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# Corticon License/Support Renewal

## Background

MHBE uses Corticon Business Rules Engine software for the end-to-end automation and management of Eligibility & Enrollment decision making functions of the Health Benefit Exchange (HBX) System.

## Procurement Summary

- The current License period (2 years) is from **August 1, 2021 – July 31, 2023**
- The approved reseller is **vCloud Tech Inc.**
- Total cost of Corticon License for the two years is **\$694,116**
- The cost of licenses for the Year 1 (FY 2022) is **\$333,906**
- The cost of licenses for the Year 2 (FY 2023) is **\$360,210**

# License Costs

## Cost of Licenses/Support for the two years FY 2022 and FY 2023
